His primary research and clinical interests are in Functional neurosurgery, Epilepsy Surgery, Brain tumor, Neuromodulation and Neuroimmunology.

Recently, he discovered the potential for focused ultrasound to make a significant contribution to clinical practice.

He has lectured in great demand as a speaker in the area of Epilepsy Surgery and Functional Neurosurgical Research.

He serves as the board member of the Japan Neurosurgical Society, Japanese Society for Stereotactic and Functional Neurosurgery, Japan Epilepsy Society, Japanese Neuromodulation Society, Asian-Australasian Society for Stereotactic Functional Neurosurgery, and Asia Epilepsy Surgery Congress.

He served as the president of the 13th Asian Epilepsy Surgery Congress (AESC2019) and the 13th Scientific meeting of Asian Australasian Society for Stereotactic and Functional Neurosurgery (AASSFN2023). He will be the president of the 25th Annual Meeting of the Japanese Society of NPH and The 32nd Conference on Neurosurgical Techniques and Tools (CNTT2025, Japan).
